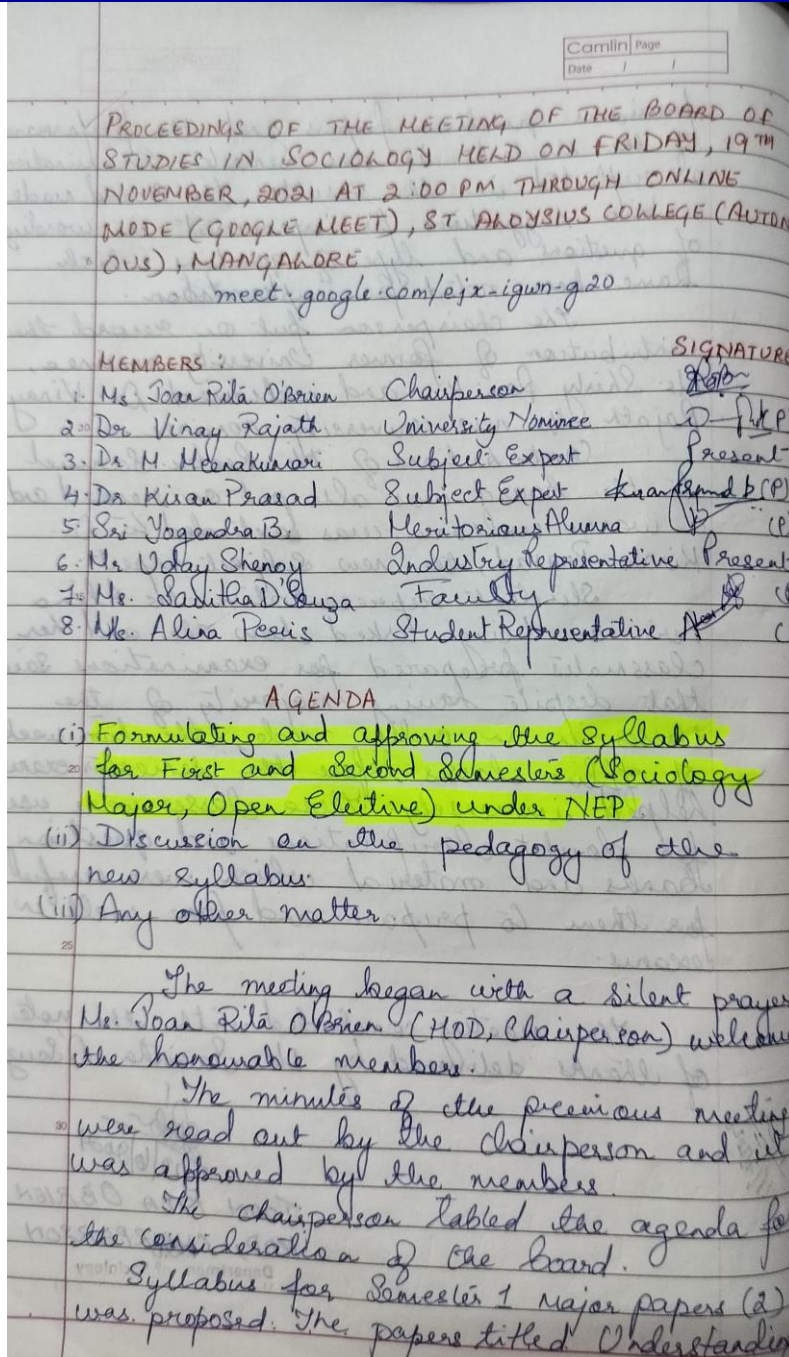


The board discussed on various innovative methods of teaching and learning which was fundamental to the NEP.
