Minutes of the meeting:

- Results of August 2021 were placed before the board and were appreciated by the members.
- Question papers of August 2021 were place! before the members and were discussed.
- The main agenda was approval of NEP syllabus. The suggestions were asked regarding this matter and Number Theory - I, Algebra – I and Calculus – I was approved as the major paper for I BSc.
- Mathematics I paper was approved as the Other Elective paper as it is to be offered to the students of science stream only.
- To expose the students to basic programming skills and to support traditional teaching methods with modern tools, practicals using Maxima for Credit 2 has been introduced.
- Question paper pattern of I BSc was changed after discussion with the panel. The following pattern was approved:

Major paper:

- Part A: Carrying 18 marks (9 questions out of 12 to be answered, each carrying 2 marks).
- Part B: Carrying 42 marks (Each unit having a weightage of 14 marks. From each unit, 2 questions to be answered out of 3, each carrying 7 marks. The questions may contain sub questions).
