PROCEEDINGS OF THE TWENTIETH ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING

The Twentieth meeting of the Academic Council of St Aloysius College (Autonomous), Mangaluru was held at 10.00 AM on 19 June, 2021 at 10.00 AM on Zoom Virtual Platform.

Rev. Dr Praveen Martis, SJ, Principal and the Chairperson of the Academic Council presided over the meeting. Rev Fr Marcel Rodrigues, SJ, the Secretary, and Dr Alwyn D'Sa, Controller of Examinations were present.

78 members attended the meeting.

The meeting started with a prayer rendered by Rev. Fr Vincent Pinto, SJ.

Rev. Dr Praveen Martis, SJ, the Chairperson accorded a warm welcome to all esteemed members of the Academic Council.

A brief report on the academic, co-curricular & extracurricular events held during the period from the previous Academic Council meeting was presented in the form of a video.

The agenda were taken up for discussion:

Agenda-1 ACM 20: To record the proceedings of the Nineteenth Academic Council meeting held on 2-12-2020 and the action taken report.

The proceedings of the previous meeting held on 02-12-2020 were placed before the house with the action taken report.

Resolution: Approved

Agenda-2 ACM 20: To review the examination results of the Odd semester Undergraduate/Postgraduate programmes 2020-21

The results of the Odd Semester Undergraduate and postgraduate programmes were presented before the house by the Controller of Examinations.

Agenda-3 ACM 20: To Propose and approve the list of Rank Holders of 2016-19 (Undergraduate) and 2017-19 (Postgraduate) batches

The final list of Rank Holders of the batches of Undergraduate (2016-19) and Postgraduate (2017-19) was placed before the members.

A Blended Felicitation Programme was organized on 15-12-2021 to the Rank Holders awarding the Rank Certificates, Medals and cash prizes.

Agenda-4 ACM 20: To propose and approve the syllabi of the mandatory credit/noncredit course in Research Methodology & Ethics of all PG programmes.

Members shared their view that the initiative is appropriate as the NEP-2020 proposes serious research in the fourth year of the (honours) undergraduate programmes.

Resolution: Approved

Action Taken: Implemented

Agenda-5 ACM 20: To consider and approve the proposal to start Skill Based and Job oriented Certificate and Diploma programmes in the field of Horticulture and Agricultural Sciences under DDU Kaushal Kendra.

A presentation was made on the new campus where these programmes will be implemented along with some tentative plans and possibilities for initiating the programmes.

Resolution: It was resolved that the proposal could be approved after making a feasibility study, identification of specific certificate and diploma programmes along with their curricular structure, syllabi and proposing the same in the coming Academic Council Meetings.

Action Taken: A special committee consisting of the management representatives, experts in the field along with the industry partners has been constituted to make a feasibility study and shortlisting specific programmes and collaborations for implementation. The Committee is expected to submit a report and recommendations to the management within six months' time. An exclusive Board of Studies for programmes also is put in place.

Agenda-6 ACM 20: To propose and approve the comprehensive list of POs, PSOs and COS of all UG/PG curricula /programmes.

Resolution: Approved

Action Taken: An exercise in mapping the student attainment levels in the UG/PG programmes against POs, PSOs and COs is undertaken. All the end semester results of UG/PG programmes of the last academic year are subjected to mapping against their

Learning outcomes under LOCF. The generally observed outcome of the mapping (mean) has been between 3 & 4 descriptively represented as "High" to "Higher".

Agenda-7 ACM 20: To Propose and approve the finalized syllabus of B.Com (Apprenticeship/Internship Embedded) duly approved by BOS in Commerce along with the finalized MoU with Internship agency

Resolution: Approved subject to approval of the proposal by the University.

Action Taken: The proposal has been approved by the statutory bodies of the University and sent to Bangalore for the nomenclature to be included in the University list of approved nomenclatures.

The programme has been received with great enthusiasm. The first batch of 80 students has been admitted and the first semester has commenced. Formal MoUs have been entered into for providing internships to students in the 6th Semester.

The comprehensive feedback on the curriculum from all UG/PG departments was presented graphically to members.

Resolution: Approved

Action Taken: A modified and more comprehensive template for collecting the feedback from all stakeholders has been designed and will be utilized in the future..

Agenda-22 ACM 20: To consider and approve the proposal to initiate the process of the implementation of NEP- 2020 in a phased manner from 2021-22.

The Chairperson of the Task force on NEP Implementation made an elaborate presentation on the pattern and strategies adopted for implementation.

Members expressed their concerns regarding the lack of clarity in the actual implementation of specific details of the policy.

It was also suggested that the College get clarifications on specific queries on the implementation from relevant authorities.

Concerns were also expressed on the question of sustainability/survival of private unaided institutions.

Resolution: Approved subject to the final announcement of the Regulations and guidelines with clarity on specific action plan of implementation. Meanwhile, it was decided that as an academic family, a specific plan of action needs to be prepared to make the policy operational making use of the provisions given by UGC/ State Higher Educational Council/ Mangalore University.

Action Taken: The Institutional Taskforce has made several rounds of discussions and deliberations with authorities and has evolved a viable strategy/model in tune with the state and university regulations.

The College has prepared its own regulations, 2021 making use of the provisions of the policy, state, university regulations and the autonomous status. The regulations of the College will be proposed in the AC Meeting-21 for approval of the house.

All UG departments of the College have conducted their respective Board of Studies meetings and have designed the structures of curricula and course syllabi as per NEP regulations and will propose the same in the upcoming AC Meeting-21.

Agenda-23 ACM 20: To consider and approve the proposal of introducing the Elective Courses in NCC for cadets during the first four semesters from 2021-22. Members suggested that the value of tolerance, democratic principles and pluralism are to be the integral part of NCC training.

Resolution: Approved

Action Taken: As the College has not received any guidelines regarding integrating NCC

as one of the core electives, the proposal has been kept on hold.

However, NCC will be an integral part of the curriculum during semesters 2-6 as part of

EC/CC activities.
