Mangalore: In the view of the World Hindi Day Celebration, a one day International Hindi Webinar was held on Jan 8 at St. Aloysius College (Autonomous), Mangaluru. Dr Mukunda Prabhu, Head of the Department of Hindi gave his introductory speech on the theme of the webinar- 'Hindi Language and Literature in the Non-Hindi Province: In a Global Perspective'.
