

## Organization of International Hindi Webinar on the occasion of World Hindi Day Celebration



In view of World Hindi Day Celebration, a one-day International Hindi Webinar was held on January 8, 2022 at St. Aloysius College (Autonomous), Mangaluru. Dr. Mukunda Prabhu, Head of the Department of Hindi gave his introductory speech on the theme of the webinar – 'Hindi Language and Literature in the NonHindi Province – In a Global Perspective'. Speaking on the occasion, Mr John Abraham, Senior Manager (Rajbhasha) of Union Bank of India and Member of the Official Language Implementation Committee, Mangalore, said that there are many languages in India. ## Webinar on Literary Modernism in Retrospect

**T**he Department of English organised a webinar on the topic “Literary Modernism in Retrospect” on November 10, 2021 at Sanidhya Hall, Admin Block.
