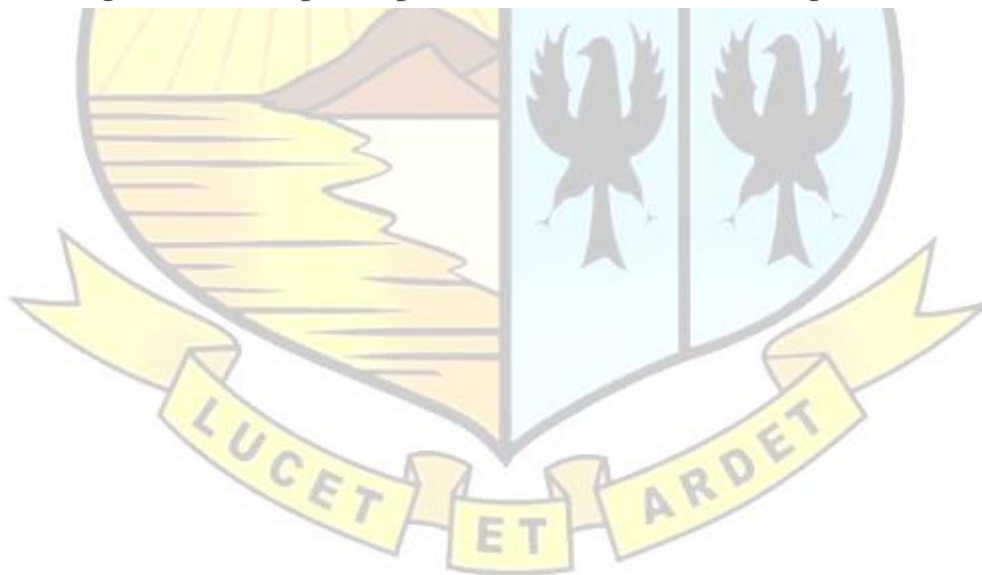

Report of Training Course in Chemical Science for KSET 2021

The Post Graduate Department of Chemistry at St Aloysius is offered a 30 hour online crash course program for the preparation of KSET 2021. The course was designed in such a way that 12 important topics were discussed with more concentration on solving **questions from previous years** and with a proper explanation of the theoretical part. All classes were taken by experts in the field and by previous year qualifiers.

The overall course was completed in **12 modules and 24 sessions**. There were practice sessions and an adequate number of **mock tests**. The **Zoom** platform was used for live sessions. The live training sessions were scheduled in the evening time. Total 17 students enrolled for the course. Fees was Rs. 1000 per student. This was not a certificate course but was a training course. All participants were from other colleges.
