Feedback Analysis:

- 1. The board members expressed unanimous agreement regarding the relevance and importance of the topics covered in the zoology syllabus. This indicates a shared understanding of the significance of the curriculum in preparing students for future endeavors in the field.
- 2. Suggestions were put forth by the members emphasizing the need for hands-on, practical learning experiences, particularly in fields like wildlife biology and ecology. They highlighted the importance of exposing students to real-world scenarios to enhance their understanding and application of theoretical concepts.
- 3. Additionally, the board members recommended the implementation of internships to provide students with exposure to various aspects of zoology and to cultivate entrepreneurial skills.

Actions Implemented:

- 1. In response to the recommendations, the Department of Zoology introduced internship programs at the Fisheries and Hydrobiology Laboratory. These internships focus on practical skills development, including ornamental fish breeding, aquarium maintenance, and other aspects relevant to entrepreneurship in the field of zoology.
- 2. Furthermore, the department organized workshops aimed at promoting field-based learning experiences. Activities such as the Campus Bird Count and demonstrations of sampling techniques in the intertidal zone were conducted to provide students with opportunities to engage directly with their environment and apply theoretical concepts in real-world settings.
