As you are aware, your institution has been recognized as a Research Center to carry out research activities leading to Ph.D. degree of Tumkur University vide notification cited at ref (1).

I am to bring to your notice that a committee was constituted by Karnataka State Higher Education Council under the Chairmanship of Prof. B.B. Kaliwal, Vice-Chancellor, Davangere University to look into the Research Centres recognized by Tumkur University. The Committee, in its report cited at ref (2) has recommended to delete all non-functional Research Centers. However, in view of the interest of the existing Ph.D. students in functional research centres, the Committee has recommended to continue the recognition only until the completion of their research leading to Ph.D. degree as per the regulations of the University. Further, the Committee has also recommended not to allot any doctoral students to the research centres located outside the territorial jurisdiction of the University.

Further, UGC in its letter cited at ref(3) has stated as follows:

"Universities shall allocate the supervisor from amongst the regular faculty members in a department or its affiliated PG Colleges/Institutes depending on the number of students per faculty member, the available specialization among the faculty supervisors and the research interest of the student. It is further clarified that any Ph.D./M.Phil degree awarded by a University under the supervision of a supervisor who is not a faculty member of the University or its affiliated PG Colleges/Institutes would be in violation of UGC (Minimum standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D.) Regulations, 2009." (Annexure-I)

UGC has also requested in the letter cited at ref(4) to ensure that no off-campus/study centre/ outreach centre is established by the university outside the territorial jurisdiction of the state. (Annexure-II)



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It is also further stated in the UGC letter cited at ref.(5) that "It has come to the Notice of University Grants Commission that some of the Universities are circumventing the provisions of UGC (Minimum Standard and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 by utilizing the services of Adjunct Faculty as supervisors. It is reiterated for the information of the Universities that only regular faculty (Not Adjunct Faculty) can be appointed as research supervisors. This is already been iterated in the earlier letter of even number dated 6th July 2015. In case of any aberration by the University, it will be proceeded against as per UGC Act 1956 and the name of the University will be put in the defaulters list on the UGC Website." (Annexure-III)

The above matter was placed before the Academic Council at its meeting held on 08.07.2016. The Academic Council, after a threadbare discussion, resolved to continue the recognition of functional research centres and the Ph.D. Guideship of recognized guides in such research centres only until the Ph.D. candidates in such research centres submit their Ph.D. thesis leading to Ph.D. degree or the maximum period for completion of Ph.D. as specified in the concerned Ph.D. Regulations of the University, whichever is earlier. The Council also resolved to bring to the notice of research centres the contents of the UGC letters cited at ref (6). The Syndicate at its meeting held on 23.07.2016 approved the decisions of the Academic Council meeting cited at ref (7).

Pursuant to the recommendations of the committee constituted by Karnataka State Higher Education Council cited at ref (2), the decision of the Academic Council and Syndicate, and the approval of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor cited at ref (8), I am directed to inform you that the recognition granted to your institution as a research centre of Tumkur University vide Notification cited at ref (1) and the Ph.D. Guideship of recognized guides in your research centre is valid only until the Ph.D. candidates submit their Ph.D. thesis leading to Ph.D. degree or the maximum period for completion of Ph.D. as specified in the concerned Ph.D. Regulations of the University, whichever is earlier.

The UGC letters cited at ref (3-5) are enclosed herewith for your information.

You are hereby informed to bring the above information to the notice of recognized Ph.D. Guides and Ph.D. candidates in your research centre and submit the duly signed Undertaking enclosed herewith, within 15 days from the date of this letter.
