III. PROGRAM MANAGEMENT

UIA and SAC jointly agree to selop and establish provisions for program implementation

It is understood that the details of joint activities, conditions for utilization of results It is understood that the details of joint activities, exchanges and other forms of cooperation will be negotiated for each specific type of activity.

It is also understood that financial arrangements will be negotiated in each specific type of activity and will depend upon the availability of funds. Each party agrees to seek financial resources for supporting the exchange and collaboration. The contact and exchanges between the two parties shall be on the basis of friendship, equality, and mutual assistance.

The linkage program at UIA will be under the jurisdiction of Direction of Academic Cooperation and supervised by and managed by Mtra. Sonia Elizabeth Fernández Orozco. Director of Academic Cooperation. The program at SAC will be under the jurisdiction of the Principal of St. Aloysius College and managed by the Dean of International Relations.

IV. TERMS OF UNDERSTANDING

This understanding is effective on the date of the last signature hereto and will remain in effect for an initial period of five years and may be extended for a period as mutually agreed by both parties. The agreement can be terminated by either institution by giving six-months notice to the other party.

The activities under this understanding will be reviewed on an annual basis as mutually agreed and plans for future activities will be developed each year immediately following the review.
