



This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU) is made on this 11th (Tuesday) day of the month of April in the year 2017 by and between the Central Institute of Fisheries Technology, Cochin [hereinafter called "ICAR CIFT"/First party], a constituent Research Institution of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research, Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi-110 001

On the ONE PART and the St. Aloysius College (Autonomous) [Name of the AU/ICAR-DU (Within NARS) or Central/State Govt./Public Sector Funded Institution/State University/Autonomous Body/Private University or Institution having its headquarters at Mangaluru - 573003.

[Hereinafter called "St. Aloysius College (Autonomous)"/Second Party] on the OTHER PART (who for the purpose of this MoU are hereinafter collectively referred to as the parties).

The ICAR CIFT and the second party, having discussed fields of common research interests and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into long-term collaboration for promotion of students' training and quality postgraduate research in cutting edge areas in accordance with the provisions contained in the Guidelines issued vide Letter No. 2-8/2012-HRD dated 11th December, 2012 or as revised from time to time.

WHEREAS the "ICAR CIFT" is the only research institute in India which caters to the broad spectrum of fisheries from harvest to post-harvest operations since 1957 under ICAR. Institute has 7 divisions that coordinates its activities across various disciplines includes Fishing Technology, Fish Processing, Biochemistry and Nutrition, Quality Assurance and Management, Microbiology, Fermentation and Biotechnology, Engineering and Extension-Information and Statistics.

AND

WHEREAS the "Second Party" St. Aloysius College (Autonomous), administrated by established The Mangalore Jesuits Education Society (MJES) a society registered under vide F. No 12/73-74 by The Mysore societies Registration act, 1960 (Mysore Act no. 17 of 1960 and recognized under section 2 (f) & 12 (B) of UGC Act, 1956 by University Grants Commission, at its Department of Food Science and Technology is involved in the academics and research. A post graduate program in Food science and Technology is offering in academics and in research. Presently 05 faculty members are working in various applications of food such as biofunctionalities, nutrition profiling and new product development of different food materials especially fish and meat, cereals, spices and dairy products.

Article 1. Scope

- 1.1 The St. Aloysius College (Autonomous) (Second party) recognized the ICAR CIFT for conducting research related to the thesis requirement of the research students for Master degree and Doctoral degree (Name of the degree programme). The St. Aloysius College (Autonomous) (Second party) recognized Scientists of the ICAR CIFT as recommended by its Director in accordance with the University rules and regulations for guiding students working for the said degree.
- 1.2 Operational details of research effort and collaboration will be made in common research programmes and/or projects restricted to specific mandated domain within the approved disciplines/divisions. The objective(s) for research work for a student coming from a St. Aloysius College (Autonomous) (Second party) should be exclusively different as far as possible.
- 1.3 Research instrumentation facility and library facilities available with the ICAR CIFT and the St. Aloysius College (Autonomous) (Second party) will be made



Article 1. Scope

- 1.1 The St. Aloysius College (Autonomous) (Second party) recognized the ICAR CIFT for conducting research related to the thesis requirement of the research students for Master degree and Doctoral degree (Name of the degree programme). The St. Aloysius College (Autonomous) (Second party) recognized Scientists of the ICAR CIFT as recommended by its Director in accordance with the University rules and regulations for guiding students working for the said degree.
- 1.2 Operational details of research effort and collaboration will be made in common research programmes and/or projects restricted to specific mandated domain within the approved disciplines/divisions. The objective(s) for research work for a student coming from a St. Aloysius College (Autonomous) (Second party) should be exclusively different as far as possible.
- 1.3 Research instrumentation facility and library facilities available with the ICAR CIFT and the St. Aloysius College (Autonomous) (Second party) will be made

available to the faculty and research scholars. However, the costs of specific consumables will be borne by the Student / St. Aloysius College (Autonomous). (Respective organizations).

Article 2. Management

- 2.1 Director of the ICAR CIFT and the Vice-Chancellor/Head of the Institution of the Second party will be responsible to work out operational details of co-operation between the two organizations and ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.
- 2.2 The Advisory Committee will meet at least once in a year alternatively either in ICAR CIFT or in the St. Aloysius College (Autonomous) (Second party) to review the activities. This meeting shall include presentation on the academic and research activities, which should be open to the students, faculty and scientists.

Article 3. Exchange of Information

- 3.1 The term "information" includes scientific or technical data, results and/or methods of investigation, and other information intended to be provided, exchanged, or arising under project descriptions entered into pursuant to this MoU.
- 3.2 The parties support the widest possible dissemination of information. Each party in joint projects shall be given the right to use, disclose, publish or disseminate such information for any and all purposes.

Article 4. General Provisions

- 4.1 It is understood that the ICAR CIFT and the Second party subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, caste or religion. Both the Institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement and neither party shall impose criteria for exchange of scholars or students, which violate principles of non-discrimination.
- 4.2 Both parties understand that all financial agreements will have to be negotiated separately and will depend on the availability of funds.
- 4.3 Both parties acknowledge that exchange of students from one party to the other shall be subject to the availability of funds and shall comply with the regulations and policies of the ICAR CIFT and the Second party.
- 4.3 The student will invariably be the senior author for the publications arising out of the research work conducted at ICAR CIFT, followed by Major Guide/Advisor and Co-major Advisor/Co-Guide in that order. The name of additional co-authors, depending up on their contribution in the research work, may be decided by mutual consent between the student and the Major Guide/Advisor.
- 4.4 Students should submit at least one paper from Master's thesis before thesis submission.
- 4.5 A copy of the thesis/dissertation will be submitted to the ICAR CIFT after the award of the degree by the Second party.
- 4.6 All questions related to this MoU arising during its term will be settled by the parties by mutual agreement. Disagreements at the operating level shall be forwarded to respective higher officials for appropriate resolution failing which an arbitrator of mutual acceptance may be identified for the settlement of dispute, if any.

- 4.7 All questions not foreseen related to this MoU will be handled by the parties by mutual agreement.
- 4.8 Nothing in this MoU is intended to affect other cooperation or collaborations between the parties.

Article 5. Intellectual Property Rights

- 5.1 The Second party will be expected to ensure protection of the Intellectual Property Rights generated or likely to be generated during the student's research work. The ICAR as the first applicant (for ICAR CIFT) and the Second party shall be the joint applicants for IPRs and the students and involved scientific staff shall be included as the inventor.


Article 6. Admission and Fees

- 6.1 The major guide/Advisor for the students will be from the ICAR CIFT if the ICAR CIFT will provide the major intellectual input and time duration devoted for carrying out the research work.
- 6.2 Admission of the students and the award of degrees for different programmes will be the responsibility of the Second party as per the rules and regulations.
- 6.3 Allotment of the students at the ICAR CIFT will be done by the approval of Director of the ICAR CIFT and Vice-Chancellor/Head of the Institution of the Second party.
- 6.4 The ICAR CIFT would have the right to screen the student's eligibility for admission based on their academic record.
- 6.5 The PME Cell of the ICAR CIFT in consultation with the representative of the Second party shall decide the location and sharing quantum of research work.
- 6.6 The number of student(s) at any particular time will be subjected to the availability of research facilities and scientists' time to guide thesis research at the ICAR CIFT.
- 6.7 Any student(s) admitted to the ICAR CIFT for training/postgraduate research, if found violating the rules and regulations laid down by the ICAR CIFT or indulge in such activities that amount to tarnishing the image of the Institute, or cause damage to the property, the registration of such student(s) would be summarily terminated. The Second party will not complete the formalities of issuing the certificates to such students until they compensate the losses to the ICAR CIFT.
- 6.8 Fees will be charged from the students by the ICAR-CIFT as per the guidelines for the students to conduct research for their degree programmes as trainees at ICAR institutions vide letter No. 2-8/2012-HRD dated 11th December, 2012 or revised guidelines, if any, as may be issued from time to time. No fee may be charged by the ICAR CIFT from the students registered with AU/DU within NARS. However, a Student registered with a second party, outside NARS, will deposit fee of Rs. 10,000/- + Tax applicable (Rupees ten thousand plus Tax applicable) for training duration of 3 months (not leading to a degree/dissertation) and Rs.30,000/- + Tax applicable (Rupees thirty thousand plus Tax applicable) per semester for training, research, dissertation exceeding three months. Any change in fee structure by ICAR will be applicable from the date of revision and shall be charged by the ICAR-CIFT.

Article 7. Entry into effect, modification and termination

- 7.1 This MoU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the parties and shall be valid for three years. Both parties shall review the status of the MoU at the

end of each three year period to determine any modification, whenever necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may be extended by mutual consent up to five years. This MoU may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party initiating termination. Such notification must be given to the other party at least six months in advance from the effective date of termination.

- 7.2 All joint activities which are not completed at the expiration or termination of the MoU may be continued until their completion under the terms of this MoU.
- 7.3 No amendment or modification of the MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be amendment of the MoU. The modifications/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed, unless otherwise agreed to.
- 7.4 This MoU has been executed in two originals, one of which has been retained by ICAR CIFT and the other by the second party
