Preamble

In accordance with a mutual objective to promote further cooperation between St Aloysius College (Autonomous)(SAC), located at St Aloysius College Road, Hampankatta,

bremail

Mangalore 575003, Karnataka, India, represented by the Principal - Fr Dr Praveen Martis S.J., and Red Drop, Indian Catholic Youth Movement, Mangalore Diocese represented by the Rev Fr Ashwin Lohith Cardoza - Director ICYM Mangalore Diocese_ agree to cooperate in regard to programs based on the principle of reciprocity. St Aloysius College (Autonomous) and Red Drop, Indian Catholic Youth Movement, Mangalore Diocese, are also referred to individually as a "party" and collectively as "parties".

This Memorandum of Understanding serves as a legal document for both parties to establish and develop their bilateral relationship.

The Objectives of the Agreement

Both parties will work together to serve the needs of the blood recipients quickly and efficiently and create awareness to the people regarding blood donation

The activities in which specific agreements may be developed include:

- Establish the list of blood Donors
- Arrange for the blood in case of emergency

St. Aloysius College (Autonomous) and Red Drop, Indian Catholic Youth Movement, Mangalore Diocese, jointly agree to develop and establish provisions for program implementation that will serve the mutual interests of both parties with the following guidelines

- Poster of Red Drop will be kept in the webpage and college app of SAC for the purpose of Blood donation.
- If any request of blood donations at SAC referred to Red Drop will add the name of the college in the requirement poster
- SAC will arrange for the blood donation only in times of requirement in collaboration with Red Drop and not for any individual camps organized by Red Drop.
- If the blood is donated by the Student of SAC credit will be given by Red Drop in the final appreciation poster to keep the track of blood units donated by SAC
- After the issue of the appreciation certificate by the Red Drop, SAC will award a certificate to the respective donor for the Academic credit. (St. Aloysius college

blood donation logo, Youth Red Cross logo, and Red Drop logo will be printed on the certificate issued by the College)

- When SAC posts the Red Drop poster and if some donor has already donated the blood, the same information must be communicated to SAC as soon as possible so that SAC will remove the poster from the website to avoid the overlap of donors for the same patient.
- In an emergency, if the donor's family or relatives needs blood then the Red Drop will try to arrange the blood from the blood bank and give the donor's family the first preference.

It is understood that the details of joint activities, conditions for utilization of results achieved, and other forms of cooperation will be negotiated for each specific type of activity, separately.

It is also understood that financial arrangements if any will be negotiated in each specific type of activity and will depend upon the availability of funds. The contract and exchanges between the two parties shall be on the basis of friendship and mutual assistance.

The related work done at St Aloysius College (Autonomous) will be under the jurisdiction of the Principal and supervised and managed by Ms Jennifer Ida Mascarenhas – Dean Extension Services and Red Drop, Indian Catholic Youth Movement, Mangalore Diocese will be under the jurisdiction of the Rev Fr Ashwin Lohith Cardoza – Director ICYM Mangalore Diocese supervised and managed by Brendon Cutinha – Red Drop Representative ICYM Mangalore Diocese

Terms of Understanding

This understanding will be effective on the date of the last signature hereto and will remain in effect for an initial period of five years and will be auto-renewed for further periods of equal time, if not amended or cancelled by either party. The agreement can be terminated by either institution by giving one-month notice to the other party. The work started before the termination shall come to their logical end without any negative impact to either party and be amicably agreed upon by both

The activities under this understanding will be reviewed on an annual basis as mutually agreed and plans for future activities developed each year immediately following the review.
