3. **Radiological Safety Officer (RSO):** In case a Radiological Safety Officer approved by AERB is not available in the institution, an employee of the institution who has successfully completed the appropriate training course on safety aspects of Research Application (for admission to which Head, Radiological Physics and Advisory Division, BARC, CT&CRS, Anushaktinagar, Mumbai 400 094, Tel -022-25515040, 25519209 may be contacted) or a course deemed equivalent by AERB should be nominated by the Consentee as the Radiological Safety Officer (RSO) of the institution, within one year from the date of issuance of the authorization.
4. **Responsibilities of employer, consentee (licensee) and RSO:** The regulatory responsibilities of the employer, Consentee (licensee), and the RSO are laid down in the Atomic Energy (Radiation Protection) Rules, 2004.
