Agenda 1: Prayer and welcome

The meeting began with a silent prayer. Dr. Rose Veera D'Souza introduced the new members Prof. Jayaraj Amin -Subject Expert and Rev. Fr Alwin Serrao -Alumnus and welcomed all the BOS members.

Agenda 2: Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Action Taken: Members approved the minutes of the previous meeting

Agenda 3: Departmental/Students Activities

Dr Joyce Lobo presented a Power point presentation on departmental activity, which included internship, exposure visits to Vidhana Soudha, visit to the Court, seminars, workshops, and guest lectures. Members appreciated and congratulated with regard to the quality of the programme organized. Vinay, student representative appreciated the departmental initiatives of internship and academic workshops and lectures held to promote the students.

Action Taken: It was decided to continue with Internship as a part of NEP Curriculum

Agenda 4: Proposing PG Programme on MA (Public Policy & Governance)
Dr Rose Veera Dsouza Presented the proposed structure and module of the new PG programme on Public Policy to be implemented in the coming year. She explained the relevance of such a course, considering the present national, global scenario.

The members suggested the following changes

- Making public policy in India to be focused
- Local (one separate paper) National and International level can be included as separate chapter
- Rights, Duties and Institutions can be retitled as the Ethical foundation of Public policy.
- Contemporary Indian polity and politics and society in India can be clubbed together
- Public policy and coastal region can be included as a separate paper

Members expressed their concern over employability, recruiting experts to teach some special paper like law and since it is a multi-disciplinary course how exactly to proceed with admission?
Dr Rose Veera Dsouza placed all the internship opportunities and at the same time, she also expressed the need for entering with MOU with a reputed institution for better placement.

Action Taken: It was decided to present the proposed structure PG programme on Public Policy with changes as suggested by BOS members before Academic Council and Governing Body after getting permission from the university for the course.

Agenda 5: Approval of NEP syllabus / Ability Enhancement Course- Indian Constitution
NEP syllabus and The Constitution of India (AEEC-2) were presented. While discussing Modern Political Analysis course Prof Tolpadys suggested to reach out to students while teaching this paper by asking the basic question like what is theory? What is Neo Liberalism? etc

Rev Fr Alwyn sought clarification with other members regarding freedom to change the syllabus and raised concern on the inability to bring in innovation changes in the syllabus and curriculum in the present system of NEP. Prof Jayaraj Amin explained that in NEP even autonomous institution must adhere to the state syllabus and they have freedom to change only 20% of the content and title of the paper to be retained as it is.

G 103 OE-41 Political Journalism


Resolution: It was Decided to teach the Political Journalism as OE4 and the Constitution of India as AEEC-2

Resolution: Following papers were selected and approved by the BOS members




