The college adopts a reservation policy in tune with the rules and regulations of Government of Karnataka and the Mangalore University, regarding the admissions to various programmes. The number of candidates seeking admissions from the Scheduled Castes (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST) categories were very few and hence all such candidates are given seats under the same.
