### Hejje—Footwear Collection

### Rural Immersion Programme

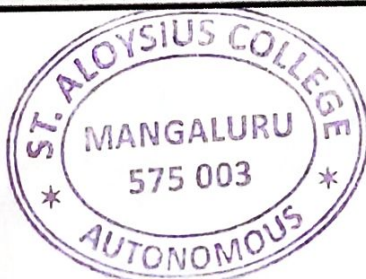
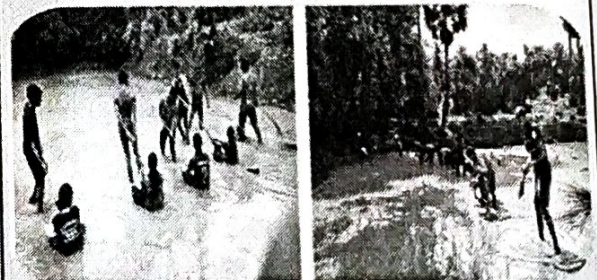

Street play at Guardian Angel's Church, Angelore, 17 September, 2023 at 8.30 am.

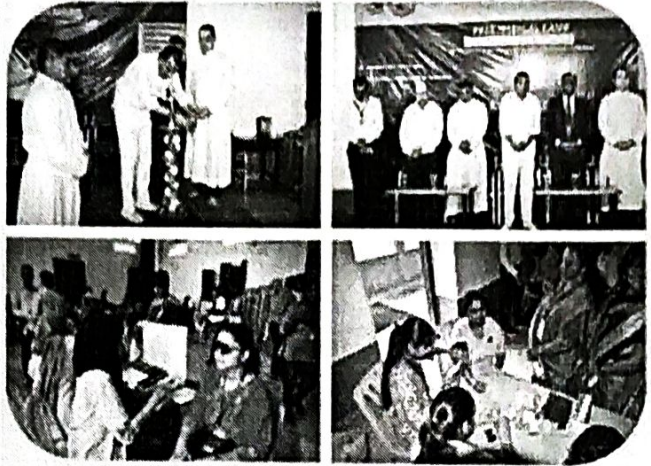

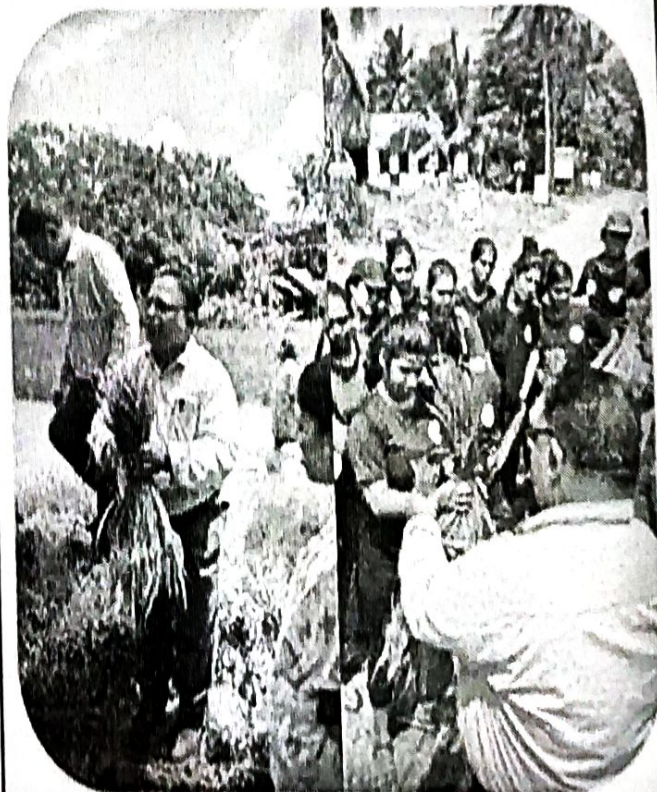
## Plantation Drive
