Visit - Mangalore South Police Station

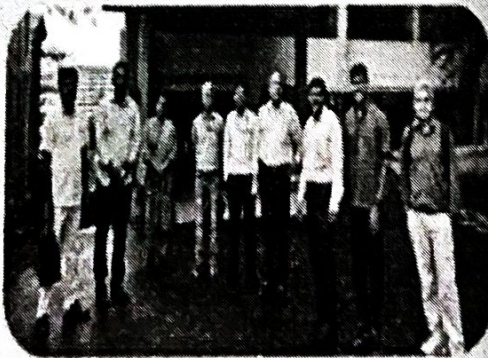

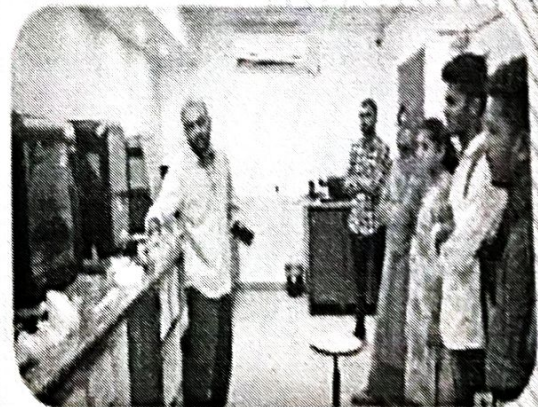

Visit to NITK Surathkal

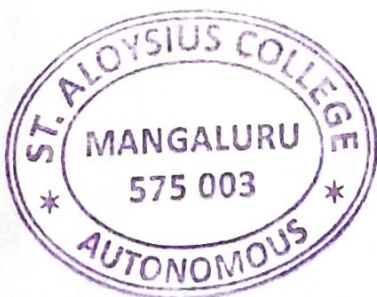

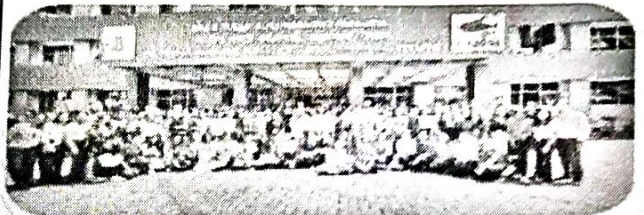
Visit to Regional Science Centre

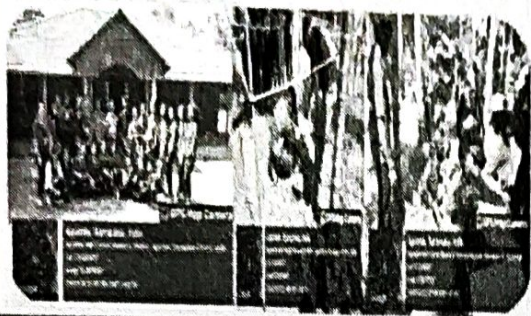

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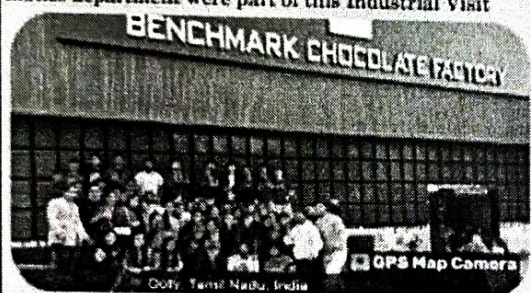
Field Visit to Agumbe

The Department has maintained close association with UNICEF, Women and Child Development Department, ICDS, Social Justice, World Bank, and Youth Welfare Board etc.

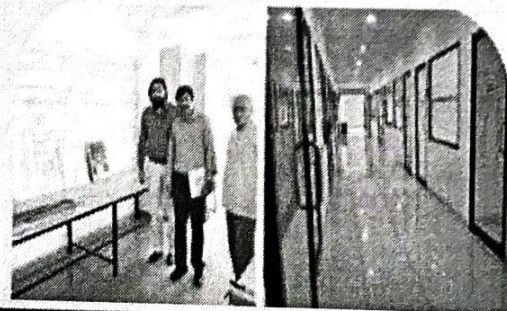

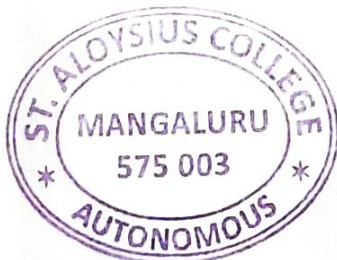
Industrial Visit at Manipal

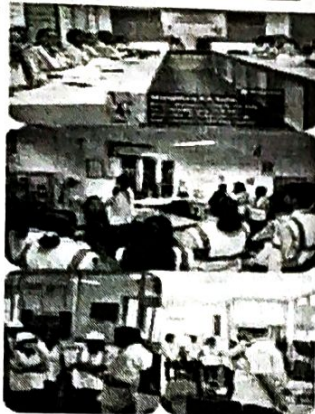
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Industrial Visit to IOCL

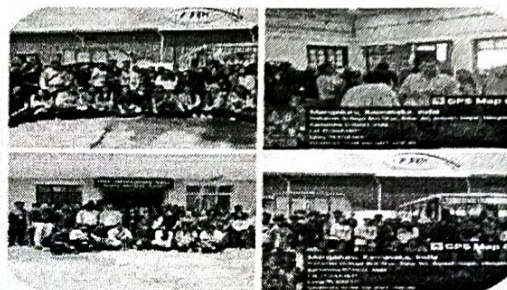
Visit to Indian Oil

Industrial Visit by PG Food Science



The Department of PG Studies and Research in Food Science organized a one-day visit to Modern Rice mill, Urva, Mangalore on 9th October, 2023. A total of 59 students from second year M.Sc. (FST & FSND) took part in the visit accompanied by 4 staff members. During the visit, the students explored the various processing technology involved in rice milling. The rice mill unit was equipped with machinery for cleaning, husking, polishing and packaging of rice. The units of industry initially separate bran and husk from the paddy and later sent for further polishing. The husk is collected in jute bags and sent to Tumkur, where the rice bran oil is extracted from it and manufactured. The rice bran oil obtained has 25% of fat in it. The capacity of the plant is 70 tons per day and the combined production capacity of rice is 100 tons per day. The visit to modern rice mill provided valuable insights on processing of rice and helped the students to gain practical knowledge on associated challenges faced by the industry through personal interactions.



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
