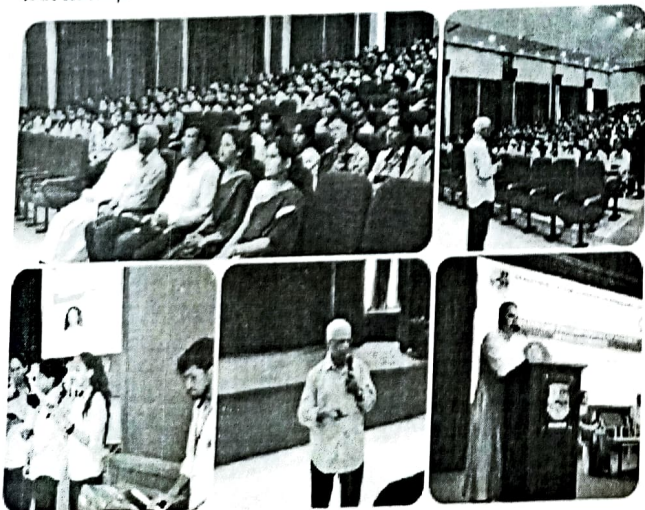
Workshop on 'Introduction to Python'

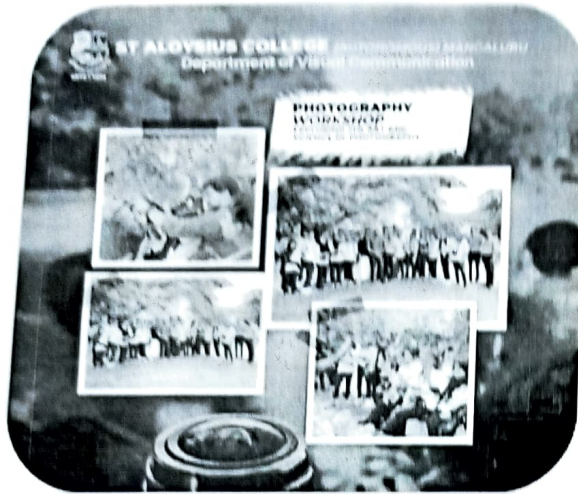

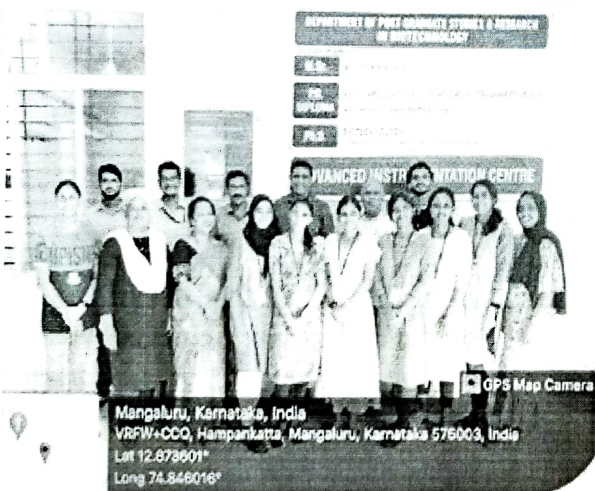
Two-Day Workshop on Membrane Biochemistry

Enhancing Skills in Biotechnology - Workshop

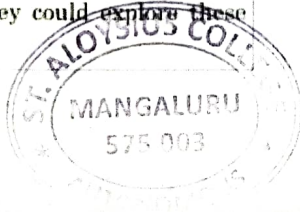

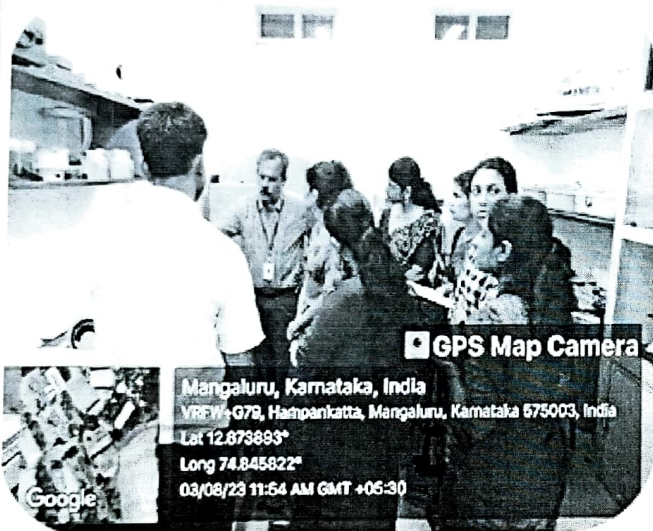
The workshop gave an extensive practical knowledge on wet lab experiments and how they could explore these studies in their future work.

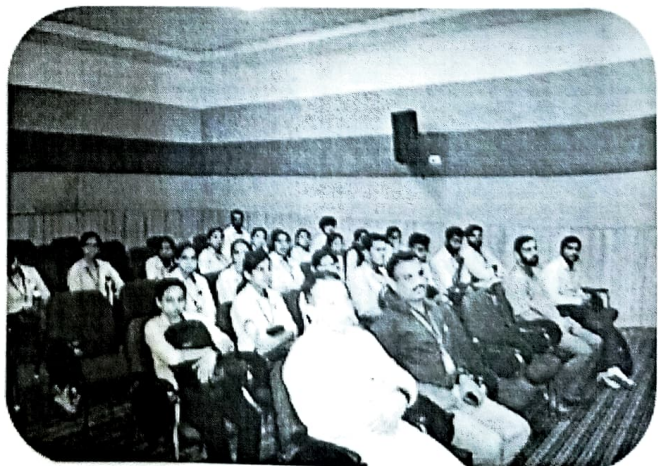


Skill Development Workshop on 'PCR Techniques'

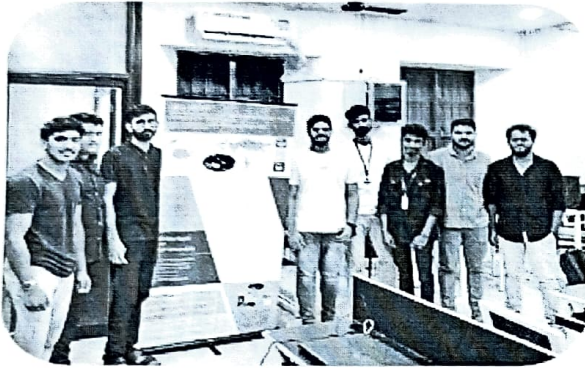

From III BCA, Ms Osheen compered, Ms Jyothi gave welcome address, and Ms Vanessa delivered vote of thanks.

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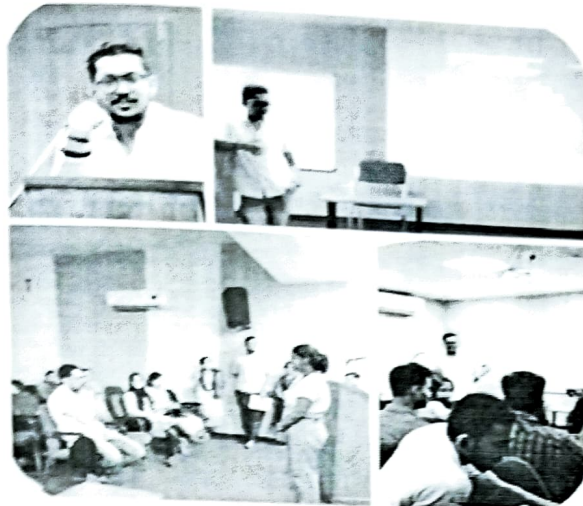

Workshop by Eco Warriors

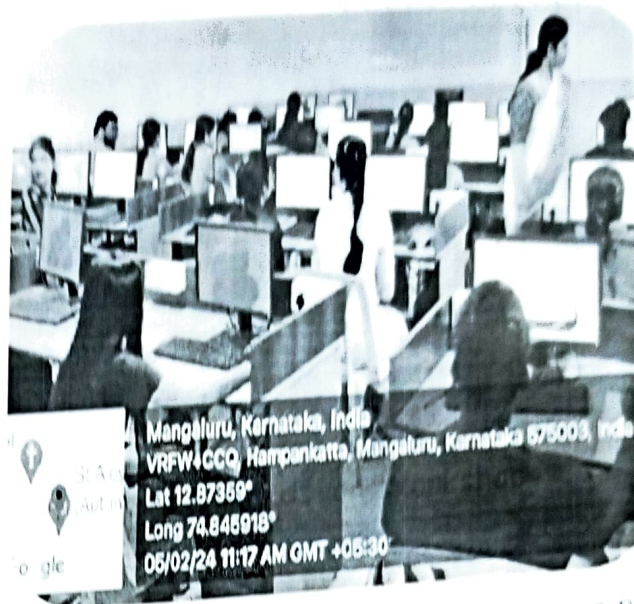

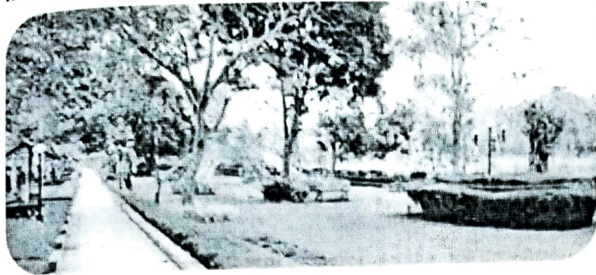

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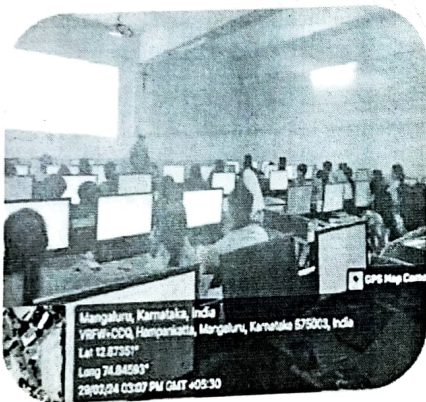
Workshop on Wikipedia Edit-A-Thon
