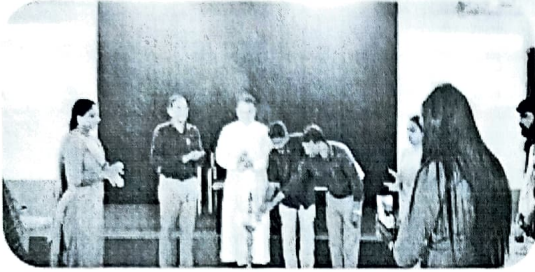


## Seminars and Webinars

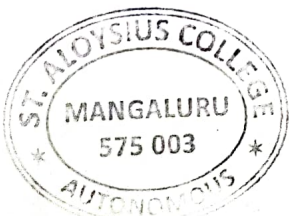
### UiPath Career Webinar Series 2023

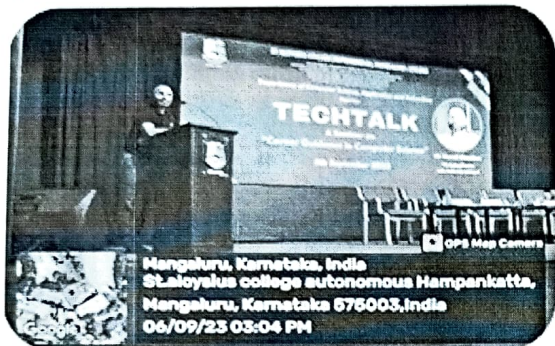

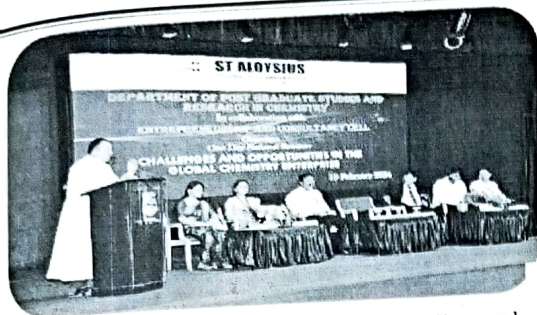

## Seminar on Campus to Corporate



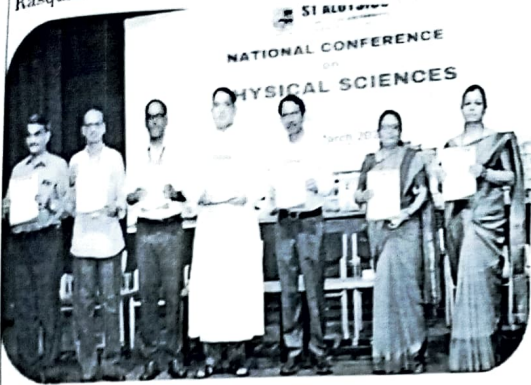
