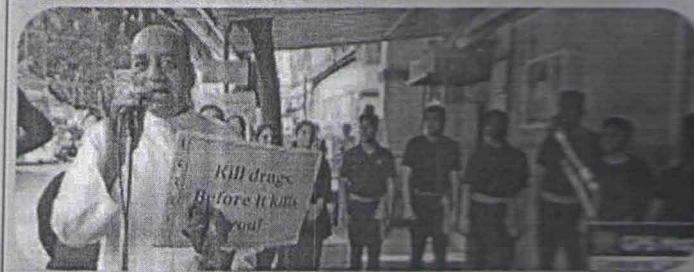

Street play at Guardian Angel's Church, Angelore, 17 September, 2023 at 8.30 am.

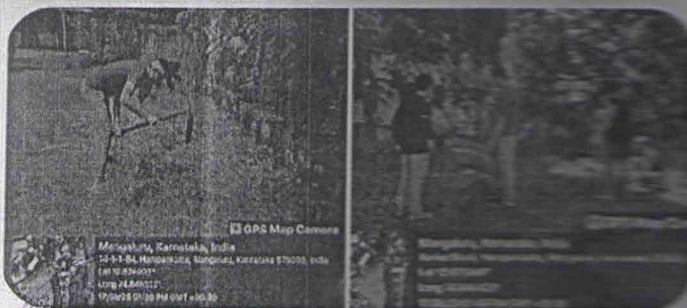

Students of Dramatics Association engaged themselves in Campus Cleaning as a part of Saahasya activity on 17 September, 2023.



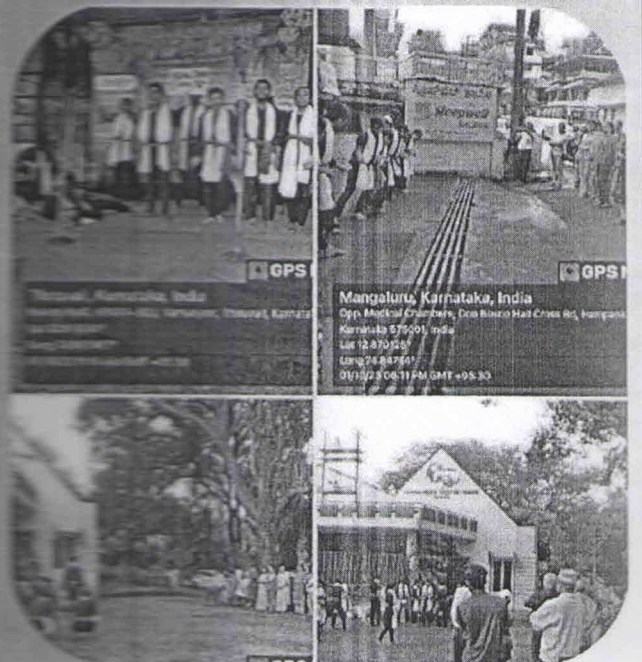
Plantation Drive
