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Minutes of Research Advisory Committee

Minutes of Research Advisory Committee meeting held on 2nd April 2024 at 3.00PM in the Conference Room of the Admin Block.

Meeting Commenced with a silent prayer followed by formal welcome by the Chairman of the meeting Vice Chancellor Rev Dr Praveen Martis SJ. Dr Chandrashekhara Shetty, Director Research and Development Cell read the minutes and action taken report on the previous meeting and it was approved by the members.

Dr Chandrashekhara Shetty presented the activities of Research and Development Cell.

The Vice Chancellor stressed upon the following points.

1. Research Collaboration should be enhanced by Faculty.
2. Within five years all permanent faculty should join PhD program.
3. All Faculties should attend research related seminars.
4. Action must be taken to register instruments in ISTEM.
5. There should be incentive for publications in Q1 and Q2 Category journals.
6. Advisory for research from each school and have meetings. Each stream wise meeting should be arranged with
 - a. One member from each school
 - b. One Jesuit representative
 - c. One RDC member.
7. Applying for new funds and appoint retired faculty for mentoring.
8. Guidelines should be drafted for PhD program.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr Chandrashekhara Shetty.
